INKA PALLETS – PHYTOSANITARY CONTROLS

I refer to our recent correspondence and telephone discussions.

You have assured me that your pallets do not in any way incorporate any solid wood material, that is, wood which has not undergone any form of manufacturing process beyond simple sawing. All of the components are moulded from wood particles which have been subjected to a process involving high temperatures, pressure and bonding agents.

As such, I can confirm that your product does not present any phytosanitary risk and meets the definition of a processed product. As such, it is not subject to any quarantine controls when imported into, or moved within, the United Kingdom. There are no documentary or inspection requirements.
