USA fights Sirex Wasp

The U.S. State of North Carolina has just issued its own **Declaration of Exterior Quarantine for (Sirex) European Wood Wasp**, which became effective on the 24th June. This has followed several years of research after a single Sirex wood wasp was discovered in the State of New York in 2004. Since this time the pest has spread to other areas in the Northeast U.S.

Subsequently, the North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services has imposed special quarantine regulations controlling the movement of Pine wood products (& packaging) from New York, Pennsylvania, Michigan, Vermont and any other state where pest has been found.

It is expected that talks involving the USDA-APHIS, NELMA, state governments and other organisations will be held in the near future.

Inka has spoken with key personnel within the North Carolina Department of Agriculture and we are advised that our current export certification still applies. However, we are assured that we will be updated should any changes occur.
